

Title: Clean solar energy at Riyadh power plant

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Synonyms for CLEAN: spotless, immaculate, pristine, stainless, spick-and-span, squeaky-clean, shiny, unsullied; Antonyms of CLEAN: dirty, unclean, filthy, stained, soiled, foul, uncleaned, ...

CLEAN definition: free from dirt; unsoiled; unstained. See examples of clean used in a sentence.

clean adjective (NO CRIME) showing that you have not done anything illegal: a clean driving licence

If you clean something or clean dirt off it, you make it free from dirt and unwanted marks, for example by washing or wiping it. If something cleans easily, it is easy to clean.

Make sure your hands are clean before you have your dinner. Hospitals need to be kept spotlessly (= extremely) clean.
