Type G plug sockets have three rectangular pins and a grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 230V.

Belize has a standard voltage of 110V/220V and a frequency of 60Hz. The commonly used plug types are A, B, and G. Depending on your device, if it supports 110V or 220V, you usually do ...

The power sockets in Belize are of type A, B and G. The standard voltage is 110 / 220 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. You need a power plug (travel) adapter in Belize.

Belize uses the same voltage as the United States and Canada, which is 110-120 volts. You will not need a voltage converter or transformer for most electronics.
