Do I need a power adapter in Peru?

In Peru, power outlets are of type A, B and C, similar to USA. A plug adapter is required for type A and C outlets. B outlets are compatible with your plugs, although they aren't always common in some areas. Bring a grounding adapter to use your three-prong type B plugs in two-prong type A outlets. Are USB adapters cheap in Peru?

Adapters are cheap in Peru; some come with multiple USB outlets to charge more than one device. Keep in mind that an adapter is different from a converter. Adapters let you plug your device into a third-party outlet without converting the electricity voltage. Continue reading this article to learn more about converters.

Does Peru need a voltage converter?

If you were to plug an American 110V device into a Peruvian 220V power socket, you'd get a few flying sparks, a whole lot of smoke, and a fried circuit board. Therefore, a voltage converter must be an obligatory accessory on a trip to Peru, right? Not so, actually.

Do I need a travel adapter for a Peru Charger?

However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Peru outlet. Peru uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types A & C (see images).
