Pristina railway station (Albanian: Stacioni i trenit n&#235; Prishtin&#235;; Serbian: ?????????? ?????????? ???????? /Pristinska zeleznicka stanica) is the central railway station in the city of Pristina,the capital of Kosovo. It opened on Tirana Boulevard (formerly 'Omladinskih Brigada') in 1936,having been constructed by a French/British company.

Where is Pristina located?

Pristina,city,capital and administrative centre of Kosovo. It is linked to Skopje,North Macedonia,by road and rail and,via Kraljevo,Serbia,to the Serbian capital of Belgrade; it also has an airport. What happened to Pristina?

Pristina is the site of a university (1970) and is a cultural centre for ethnic Albanians. Parts of the city were damaged in the 1990s by fighting, including NATO bombing, and in 2004 by ethnic violence, but Pristina was mostly spared, compared with other cities in Kosovo. Pop. (2011) 145,149.

When did Pristina become a city?

During this period,Pristina developed from a village to a major urban center of the region. Following the end of the First Balkan War in 1914,it became a part of the newly formed Kingdom of Serbia. In 1948,it was chosen as the capital of the province SAP Kosovo under the statehood of Yugoslavia.
